**DEFAULT DECISION**

On July 8, 2013, Petitioner State Board of Nursing filed a properly pled complaint seeking to discipline Respondent Marsha Cunningham. Ms. Cunningham was served with a copy of the complaint and our notice of complaint/notice of hearing by certified mail on August 17, 2013.

More than thirty days have elapsed since Ms. Cunningham was served. Ms. Cunningham has not filed an answer or otherwise responded to the complaint.

In accordance with § 621.100.2, RSMo (Supp. 2012), we enter a default decision against Ms. Cunningham establishing that the Board is entitled to the relief requested in the complaint. This default decision shall become final and may not be set aside unless a motion is filed with this Commission within thirty days of the date of this order establishing good cause for not responding to the complaint and stating facts constituting a meritorious defense.
