**DEFAULT DECISION**

On April 23, 2013, Petitioner, the State Board of Nursing, filed a properly pled complaint seeking to discipline Respondent, Joanna Oswalt. Ms. Oswalt was served with a copy of the complaint and our notice of complaint/notice of hearing by certified mail on May 20, 2013.

More than thirty days have elapsed since Ms. Oswalt was served. Ms. Oswalt has not filed an answer or otherwise responded to the complaint. On July 12, 2013, the Board filed a motion to enter a default decision.

In accordance with § 621.100.2, RSMo (Supp. 2012), we enter a default decision against Ms. Oswalt establishing that the Board is entitled to the relief requested in the complaint. This default decision shall become final and may not be set aside unless a motion is filed with this Commission within thirty days of the date of this order establishing good cause for not responding to the complaint and stating facts constituting a meritorious defense.
